

NAME: ST. VALENTINE'S COUPLES 5K

Length:5K

Date :Closest Saturday to Valentines Day

Sign-in: Two Lover's Leap at 5:45. Participants must sign as a couple, male and female. This is a relay race with a tag hand off at the start/finish line. Non couples may run but only as unofficial runners

Start: 6:30 am at Two Lover's Leap near the entrance.

Course: The race starts near the entrance to Two Lover's Leap. About 1/2 mile into the race, the course turns left onto a dirt road. The runners proceed along this road to the top of the hill where they turn right and proceed to the main road where they turn right. The course goes to a turn-around just after the Y in the road. Then it goes back to the pump station, turns left and back to the start/finish..

Finish: Near the entrance to Two Lover's Leap.

Water: One water stop. At the pump station at the Two Lover's Turn off.

First Run: This event was established by Jordan Righi in 1995.

Awards: Divisions are by 20 year blocks. A couples division is found by adding the ages of the couple. Candy to top three couples in each division.
