

NAME: THE GUAM MARATHON & MARATHON RELAY

Length: 26.2 miles

Date: Last Saturday in March

Sign-in: Pre-registered race. Applications due the Thursday before the race. Check in at 3:30am at start.

Start: 4:00am marathon 4:15am relay. The start is 200 yards from the Field House entrance by the tennis courts.

Course: Loops past the Field House and around the edge of UOG to GW road, then back to Field House. On second loop, go to Rt. 10 and then left to Rt. 4. Rithe on Rt. 4 to Paseo. Around back of Paseo to Marine Coup Drive. Right to USO, then right to run-a-round on Glass Breakwater. Back to Marine Coup Drive. Right to entrance to Big Navy. Left to Agat, then on to finish at JanZ's.

In 1991 a five person marathon relay was added. The relay starts 15 minutes after the marathon and follows the same course. Relay exchanges are at the Linda's J. Market, Adelup, Family Beach, and National Guard Reserve Building.

Finish: The finish line is in the parking lot at JanZ's.

Water: The miles are marked on the pavement and there are 115 water stops. The first water stop is at 1.8 miles, then there is one about every 2 miles the rest of the way.

First Run: Started by Joe Lawton in 1972 and is two years older than the Honolulu Marathon.

Awards: First six in each division and shirts for finishers in the marathon, first team in each relay division and tee shirts for all relay team members.
